- ➤ Technical Paper Presenter (may switch to Oral-Only, email LisaL@aiaa.org)
- **≻Oral-Only Presenter**

> WITHDRAW

- ➤ Withdraw and Submit to Another AIAA Event
 - ➤ No automatic acceptance; must go through review. For SciTech 2021, Call for Papers closes June 8.
 - > All conferences for the foreseeable future are subject to COVID-19 restrictions.
- ➤ Withdraw and Submit to Another Conference of your choice

Submit Manuscripts & Presentations

Where do I upload my Manuscript and Presentation?

- Submit manuscript and presentations with audio narration via ScholarOne Abstracts
- > Presenters will receive an email with submission access to Scholar One Abstracts

When will I be able to upload my presentation?

- ➤ May 1 May 28, 2000 hrs ET, USA for Oral-Only Presenters
- ➤ May 15 May 28, 2000 hrs ET, USA for Technical Paper Presenters



AIAA Publication Policies

No Paper, No Podium

- Must upload manuscript by due date
- Must upload presentation (PPT slides with audio) by due date

No Podium, No Paper

- ➤ An author of the paper must attend the "live" portion of the Forum to ensure the manuscript is published in the Forum's proceeding
- ➤ The presenting author must **register** with the Forum to present/access virtual features for presentation
- Currently, Crossmark will not be used for Presentation slide corrections



AIAA Publication Copyright

- ➤ The **manuscript** copyright release or license for technical paper manuscripts will be governed by selection made during manuscript submission
- ➤ The manuscript copyright and the PowerPoint Presentation copyright will not be the same (see next slide)



AIAA Publication Copyright

- > The **presentation slides** copyright:
 - What you are declaring by uploading your slides: By uploading my submission materials I hereby certify that the presentation is original, has been appropriately reviewed/cleared for public release, and does not contain any classified or other sensitive material. I grant a non-exclusive license to AIAA to publish this work and use it for all of AIAA's current and future print and electronic uses. (Note that copyright release or license for technical paper manuscripts is governed by author selections made during manuscript submission).
- ➢ Please insert the following language into your Power Point Presentation on the first or second page/slide:
 - Copyright © by ____ [author name/company name]. Published by the American Institute of Aeronautics and Astronautics, Inc., with permission.





- ➤ This is a 20-minute pre-recorded presentation consisting of slides and audio (or voice-over)
- Download the AIAA AVIATION PowerPoint template and detailed instructions at https://www.aiaa.org/aviation/presentations-papers/technical-presenter-resources



- Slide 1 must contain:
 - > Title
 - Presenter's name and organization
 - Date
 - The following copyright statement: Copyright © by ____ [author name/company name]. Published by the American Institute of Aeronautics and Astronautics, Inc., with permission.
- > Presentation (slides and audio) must be saved as a MP4 file. Max file size is 500 mb.
