CESSNA ONR STUDENT DESIGN/BUILD/FLY COMPETITION An AIAA Student Activity

The 2006 Cessna/ONR Design/Build/Fly Competition Flyoff was held at Cessna Field in Wichita, KS on the weekend of April 21-23, 2006. This was the 10th year the competition was held, and it had record participation in several ways. A total of 49 teams submitted written reports to be judged. At least 41 teams attended the flyoff, 40 of which completed the technical inspection. An estimated 500-600 students, faculty, and guests were present. Near ideal weather allowed for non-stop flights to be conducted each day. Of the 101 official flight attempts, 54 resulted in a valid score. In almost every respect, the quality of the teams, their readiness to compete, and the execution of the flights was better than in any past flyoff.

The primary design objective for this year was to fly three diverse payloads: 48 tennis balls, two 2-liter bottles of water, and a 4"x4"x24" wooden block. The score for this mission was based on cargo loading and unloading time. The change in timing from overall flight time to loading time was made to reduce the impact of pilot skill into the overall score and to reflect the importance of cargo loading time for a commercial aircraft operation. The Rated Average Cost (RAC) formula was changed to be the empty weight in pounds - greatly simplified from previous years. The two other missions included a minimum RAC mission to fly 96 tennis balls, which was scored based on RAC only, and an incremental payload mission which was scored based on the highest weight carried. The battle for the top places again included the two teams from Oklahoma State. The Black team took first place with the combination of a high report score (second overall), the lowest RAC (4.75 lb), and completion of the Payload Flexibility and Minimum RAC missions. The OSU Orange team nosed out Cal Poly SLO 24" Wood for second place. The OSU Orange team also had the top report score of 96.00. The complete standings are listed in the table below.

We owe our thanks for the success of the DBF competition to the efforts of many volunteers from Cessna Aircraft, the Office of Naval Research, and the AIAA sponsoring technical committees (Applied Aerodynamics, Aircraft Design, Flight Test, and Design Engineering). These volunteers collectively set the rules for the contest, publicize the event, gather entries, judge the written reports, and organize the flyoff. Thanks also go to the Corporate Sponsors: the Office of Naval Research, Cessna Aircraft, and the AIAA Foundation for their financial support. Special thanks go to Cessna Aircraft for hosting the flyoff this year.
